\*The annual College-Bound Seniors reports provide broad context on student SAT participation and performance. Historically, the data have included students who took the SAT at any point in high school through March of their senior year, by which time almost all college-bound students had completed testing. Over the last five years, the College Board has observed a trend in which more students are taking the SAT for the first time in May or June of their senior year. This population of college-bound students has grown into a significant segment-in 2011, nearly 50,000 students.

In order to provide a more complete view of the college-going population, since 2010 the official College-Bound Seniors cohort has included all students who tested through June of their senior year. For 2011, all trend data details are based on the full cohort.

SUBJECT: SAT Results for 2011 Graduates

We received our results for the 2011 seniors who took the SAT. I have enclosed for you a copy of the district SAT *2011 College-Bound Seniors Profile Report* for last year's graduating class, along with a copy of your school's *Profile* and *Highlights* reports.

*Quick District Summary*

- The 2011 district SAT combined average score for Critical Reading + Mathematics is 8 points lower compared to 2010, at 1175. The overall combined (CR+M+W) score is 1740, 14 points lower than 2010.
- The 2011 average Critical Reading score is 5 points lower (575) than in 2010, and the average Math score is 3 points lower (600) than 2010.
- The 2011 average Writing score (565) for Cherry Creek seniors is 9 points higher than for Colorado seniors (556).
- Cherry Creek Schools had 63 additional students take the SAT in 2011 than in 2010 (885 vs. 822); similarly, nationally 49,794 more students took the SAT while Colorado tested 72 less students in 2011.
