

Foodservice

The district will operate a school meal program in its schools which shall be under the overall supervision of the director of foodservice.

The director of foodservice shall cooperate with each school principal in matters essential to the proper functioning of the foodservice program. The responsibility for control of students using the school cafeteria shall rest with the building principal.

The Assistant Superintendent of Educational Support Services will notify the Board annually of the prices for meals to be charged in the following school year.

As required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the Board agrees to the following regulations:

1. That the foodservice programs be operated on a nonprofit basis.
2. That an approved breakfast and lunch be made available for students to meet the nutritional standards established in state and/or federal regulations, or Board Policy.
3. That free and reduced-price meals be provided students who qualify under the requirements of the free and reduced price meal program.
4. That meal prices shall be set for each school year per the requirements of S.3307, "Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010", Section 205, "Equity in School Lunch Pricing" or any amendment thereof.
5. That, for each school year, a determination will be made whether to provide meals to students qualifying for reduced price meals at no charge or to set the price for reduced price meals.

Students shall be permitted to bring meals from home and, provided precautions are taken, to go home for meals during the school day.

The district shall take part as feasible in the National School Lunch and other food programs which may become available to insure that all students in the district receive proper nourishment.

The administration shall establish regulations which conform with state and federal (or other) requirements regarding participation in programs for free and reduced price meals and supplementary food. Such regulations shall be presented to the Board from time to time for its information.
