STEM & INNOVATION

Cherry Creek is embarking on a journey of innovation designed to empower schools to imagine bold new ways to inspire student learning. Thanks to support from voters, each elementary school and middle school will receive funding to renovate space to support 21st century innovation in learning. The focus on innovation aligns with a districtwide emphasis on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) education, an interdisciplinary approach to teaching and learning using rigorous academic concepts and real-world experiences. It begins with the hands-on FOSS science curriculum and continues in cutting-edge fabrication labs and classes ranging from biomedicine to aerospace. Our Space-Act Agreement with the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) permits our students to design hardware and experiments for the International Space Station.

A state-of-the-art facility will be constructed and available to all Cherry Creek 11th- and 12th-grade students to ensure preparation for college and career in the 21st century. The district's Career and Technical Education (CTE) program connects students with unique educational opportunities that offer them access to the next generation of careers in a variety of fields. 

STUDENTS EARN PERFECT ACT SCORES

Eighteen seniors in the Cherry Creek School District earned a perfect score of 36 on the 2016 ACT test. Out of the 2.1 million students who took the 2016 ACT, less than 2,000 students, or less than one-tenth of one percent, earned a perfect score.



CONGRATULATIONS, GRADUATES

Since 1955, more than 100,000 students have graduated from the Cherry Creek School District.
