Step 1:

Select the size you wish to purchase. Please visit www.theyearbookcompany.com and select your school and log on for pricing and size options.

Step 2:

Send us your favorite hard copy or digital photo(s) along with your message typed on a separate sheet of paper by mail. (Mail everything to the address on the order form available on the website. **DO NOT DROP IT OFF AT THE SCHOOL.**)

Or you can go to www.theyearbookcompany.com and upload your digital photos, message and payment online. But your materials must be submitted all by mail or all online, not a combination of both.

Step 3:

Enjoy the look on your child's face when they see their dedication in the yearbook.

The deadline to submit your ad materials and payment will be **November 17, 2011.**

But there is an **early-bird discount for ads submitted by October 13th** so don't delay to get the best pricing.
