The Cherry Creek School District worked with county and state health experts to develop plans to provide in-person learning and protect the health of students, staff and families, even as the COVID-19 conditions and guidelines continue to change. Our goal is to do everything possible to maintain in-person learning for our students.



Starting Monday, February 7, masks will be strongly encouraged, but not required, for students and staff in the Cherry Creek School District.

Vaccination continues to be the most effective strategy for preventing the spread of COVID-19 and serious illness or hospitalization from the virus. You can find information about where to get the vaccine or booster here. Schools have KN95 and surgical-grade masks available for students or staff who want them.

Booster shots are available for anyone 12 and older who is five months past their second vaccine does. Additional Layered Prevention Strategies

New Isolation Guidance for Positive Cases

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) issued new guidance regarding isolation periods for people who test positive for COVID-19. In the

updated guidance, people with COVID-19 can isolate for 5 days instead of 10, followed by 5 days of wearing a mask around other people if they are asymptomatic or have greatly improved symptoms after day 5 of isolation. For staff and students, that means that if they test positive for COVID and are asymptomatic on day 5, that person can return to work/school on day 6 and wear a mask in compliance with the county mask mandate.

The shortened isolation period was "motivated by science demonstrating that the majority of SARS-CoV-2 transmission occurs early in the course of illness, generally in the 1-2 days prior to onset of symptoms and the 2-3 days after," the CDC said.

CCSD will use a series of overlapping prevention strategies to protect student and staff health this year. The district will:

- Promote vaccination and offer access to vaccines for families who choose to have their eligible students receive it – more information here;
- Ongoing no-cost COVID-19 testing for students, staff and community;

- Communicate known positive COVID-19 cases to Tri County Health Department so that they can contact trace with families appropriately;
- Sustain positive airflow through ventilation systems in schools;
- Continue high-touch cleanings in buses and high-traffic areas of schools;
- · Reinforce handwashing with students and staff; and
- Reinforce the importance of students and staff staying home if sick or experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.



From CDPHE:

- The FDA has authorized COVID-19 vaccines for children as young as 6 months old. Vaccines for children under 5 years of age will be available in Colorado starting Wednesday, June 22.
- Many vaccine providers are now taking appointments for this age group in advance. Find a list of vaccine providers for young children, or use the map

on our vaccine finder page to find a provider near you.

- Beginning June 22, all mobile vaccine clinics will have vaccines for younger children. Find an appointment at a mobile clinic.
- If you need a follow-up dose, ask about getting one at the time of your child's vaccination. Many providers offer follow-up doses to parents/guardians along with pediatric COVID-19 vaccines.





COVID-19 Data Tracking

In order to provide complete transparency and an accurate picture of COVID-19 cases associated with schools, we are posting the number and rates of positive cases among students and staff.

At this time, Tri-County is not quarantining in schools unless there is an identified outbreak. If specific individuals are considered directly impacted, they will be contacted by Tri-County.

**The data in the chart below reflects the current number of active reported cases. Reportable cases include students and staff who had an impact on our school environment and where potential exposure occurred. They do not include unconfirmed cases or cases where the individual was not in attendance during their infectious period. Cases drop off the chart after a person's isolation period ends.
