



CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

Concurrent enrollment courses are offered through the Community College of Aurora (CCA) and in addition to earning high school credit, students will have the opportunity to earn college credit at the same time at no cost to you. Eligible students earning a C or better in any concurrent enrollment course will receive college credit from CCA good toward a degree from any college or university in Colorado. If a student chooses to attend college out of state, he or she should check with that school to confirm the transfer of credit.

*In order to be eligible to receive this free college credit from CCA in the fall, a student must complete the following: 1) Obtain an S number from CCA by applying for admission and 2) Complete the Concurrent Enrollment Course Agreement (you will receive this in your CE class). Completing step 1 prior to the first day of school will help with the overall registration process.

Note: If a student previously took a concurrent enrollment class, they may already have an S number (student ID number). If a student already has an S number, they do not need to enroll again. They do still need to complete the Concurrent Enrollment Course Agreement.
