Dear Eaglecrest High School Community,

In the recent weeks the Sheriff's Office has received numerous complaints in regards to traffic concerns in and around Eaglecrest High School. School Resource Officers, Patrol deputies and the Traffic Unit have all observed numerous violations while working traffic enforcement in the area.

We would like to remind all involved of the personal responsibility to traffic safety while traveling within the school zone. Specifically; yielding to pedestrians in the crosswalk, following speed limits, crossing at crosswalks and parking responsibly. Also, stopping on the roadway to load and unload passengers is unsafe and a traffic infraction. Examples of the consequences of these violations include, but are not limited to:

42-4-1101(1)	Speeding (20-24 MPH Over Posted Limit in School Zone)	6 points	\$485 Fine
42-4-1101(1)	Speeding (10-19 MPH Over Posted Limit in School Zone)	4 Points	\$323 Fine
42-4-802(1)	Failed to Yield Right-of-Way to Pedestrian in Crosswalk	4 Points	\$73 Fine
42-4-805(7)	Vehicle (Endangered/Impeded) Traffic to Pick Up Pedestrian	0 Points	\$43 Fine
42-4-803	Pedestrian Failed to Cross Roadway as Required	0 points	\$43 Fine
42-4-709	Driver Stopped Vehicle in Crosswalk When Prohibited	3 points	\$161 Fine

The Arapahoe County Sheriff Office is working diligently with the Cherry Creek School District to address and develop solutions to traffic delays and safety issues in and around Eaglecrest High School.

Deputies assigned to Traffic and School Resources will be increasing enforcement as necessary to provide safety for those traveling in the area.
