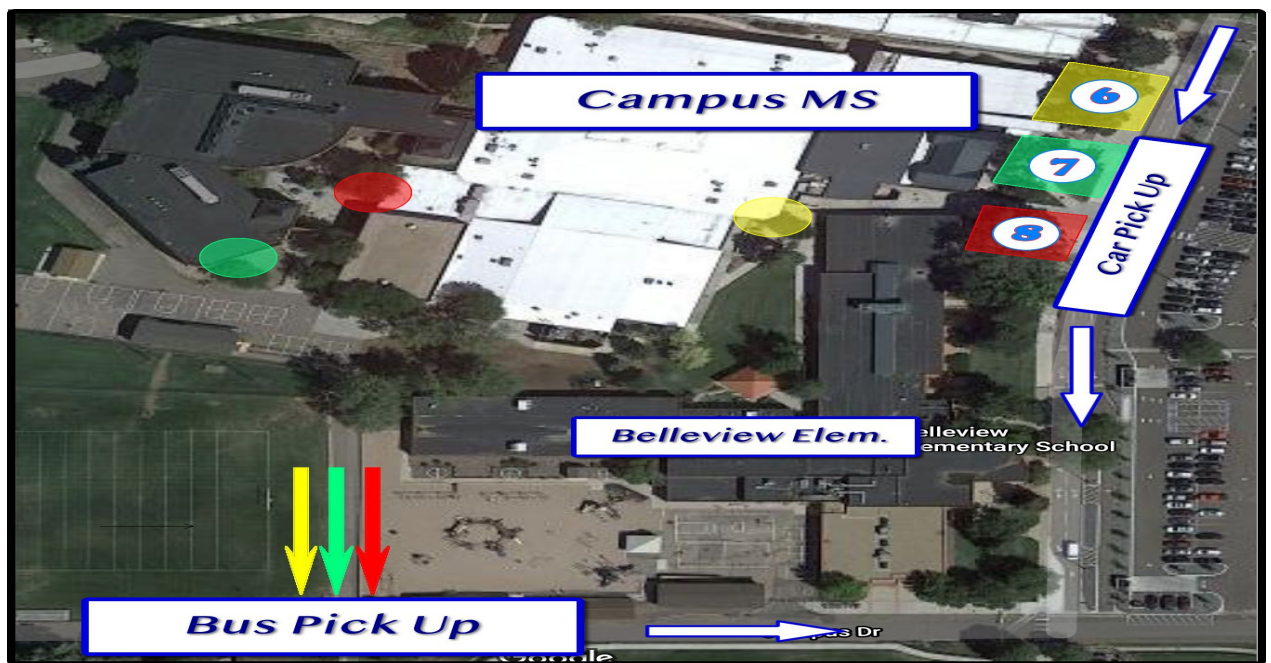

Before students arrive next week, I wanted to share some logistical reminders:

- Staff and students are expected to wear masks at all times except for when they are eating (students need to be seated at a desk or a table), or when they are outdoors and physically distanced from others (six feet). Masks need to fit and be worn properly (over the nose).
- We are asking students to stay safely distanced as they enter the building and move through the hallways.
- We have removed microwaves from the cafeteria.

I want to reiterate how well students have done learning these new procedures this week!

Because we are maintaining grade level cohorting through the day, our pick-up procedures in front of the school have been redesigned to keep grade levels separate. Thank you in advance for your patience as we all get used to this new system. Please see the map below to understand the different pick-up stations of each grade level.



Finally, I want to explain our virtual Back-to-School Night, scheduled for Thursday, August 27. Since we can't all come together here at school, we will be creating recorded information sessions and emailing those videos to you. On Thursday, between noon and 5:00 pm, you will receive in your parent/guardian email:

- An informational video prepared by the CMS Leadership Team (this should be similar to what families would normally experience during our welcome session in the gymnasium)
- An informational video prepared by each of your child's six teachers

We hope the information presented to you is welcoming and helpful, and we hope that it gives you a feel for what is going on at school and in the classroom. After watching the
