Pick courses to fill each square:

- Yearlong classes are worth 1.0 credit and take up a full row (both semester boxes)

Students will select 7.25 credits: 4.0 core (recommended by teachers) and 3.0 elective. Students cannot pick which semester or which period they will have classes. This chart is to help understand how many electives will fit into the student’s schedule.

**Notes on Electives:** Spread out electives across different departments (for example: do not pick all PE classes since students can only take 1 each semester) and there is a better chance of classes working out. Students should not pick more than 2 first-choice elective classes per department. Use the back side of this sheet to see all the elective options.
