



Concurrent Enrollment: Earn high school credit and college credit at the same time. Courses offered through local community colleges and taught at CCSD high schools by accredited, post-secondary teachers. Courses are free if the student completes the required paperwork including COF.

Dual Enrollment: Similar to Concurrent Enrollment. Families incur a small tuition cost to enroll. Courses offered through Metro State and University of Colorado Denver and taught at CCSD high schools.

Important Notes

Some courses have prerequisites that must be met in order to be eligible to earn college credit.

Student must do the following to earn college credit:

- Satisfy prerequisites

- Apply to the college
- Get a C or higher
- Be enrolled the entire term

For the course to be tuition free, the student must apply for COF (Colorado Opportunity Fund) during the college application process.
