Monday, August 12 – Phase-in day for 9th grade students only (8:20am-12:30pm)

Tuesday, August 13 - Phase-in day for 9th grade students only (8:20am-12:30pm)

Wednesday, August 14 – First day of regular “A day” classes for all students (Advisory Schedule)

Students **will not be required** to attend in-person check in this year. You are able to complete the process by reviewing the attached packet of information. If you still wish to attend an in-person check-in, we will **offer a drop-in check-in day from 12pm to 5 pm on July 31st** in the East Gym of OHS. Students who are new to OHS and speak more than one language are **STRONGLY** encouraged to attend.

CHERRY CREEK SCHOOL DISTRICT ONLINE PARENT FORMS (all students, must be completed each year)

- Per the recent CCSD email, parents must log into my.cherrycreekschools.org to complete Parent Forms and the district check-in process. Please follow the instructions provided within the email to complete these forms for each of your student(s) attending Overland (✓ = complete). **The forms must be completed online yearly before your student(s) attends classes at Overland High School in August.** Click [HERE](#) for further details regarding the district Parent Forms. - We highly encourage you to opt-in (choose "yes") at the Parent Contact Information page to receive important school announcements, student grade reports, and information from various school entities such as the OHS PTCO.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

Overland High School will **NOT** be requiring an in-person check-in this year. Instead, the components of our traditional check-in will be accomplished through other means as outlined below. Please click [HERE](#) or visit the OHS Website (Our School--- Student Check-in Process) for additional information pertaining to the start of the 2024-25 school year.

- STUDENT PICTURES/IDs (all students):** Student pictures (used for student IDs and the yearbook) will be taken during the school day on Friday, August 16. Make up day will be October 23rd during the school day.
- PARKING PASSES (11th & 12th grade students):** Juniors and seniors who would like to request a parking pass, please click [HERE](#) or visit the OHS website (under Our School---Security---Parking) to complete the Parking Registration Form. Be sure to have the corresponding registration, insurance, license plate, and car information available to complete this process. If your student has unpaid fees/fines, your student will not be able to purchase a parking pass.
- LAPTOP COMPUTERS (9th grade and new students to OHS):** 9th graders will receive their laptops during the Phase-in days on August 12th and 13th. All other students new to OHS will receive their devices from the tech office at the beginning of the school year.
- PAYMENT – FEES/FINES (all students):** You are encouraged to pre-pay all fees and fines via RevTrak by clicking [HERE](#) or visiting the OHS website (Payments---High Schools---Overland HS---Student Fees) no later than Friday, August 9.
- STUDENT SCHEDULES (all students):** Student schedules will be communicated on August 8. If you have not completed the required CCSD online Parent Forms (see #1 above), your student(s) will not receive a schedule or be able to attend classes.
- ATHLETIC ONLINE CHECK-IN (For FALL student athletes ONLY):** Go to <https://overlandhs.rschoorteams.com/> to register for a FALL sport (Winter and Spring registration dates TBA). A current physical must be uploaded into your account.

Student Check-in To Do List

Use this list to guide you through the online check-in process.

1. Activities

Learn about clubs, activities, and other opportunities to get involved at the “O”

2. Parking Passes

Review parking pass requirements to ensure you have what is needed to park at OHS. Parking pass application will be available on **July 31st**.

3. Yearbook

Purchase a yearbook, [submit senior portraits](#) etc.

4. Health Clinic & Medication Questions

Medications and medical related questions.

5. Bookkeeper

Pay historical fees/fines, pre-pay for SY2024-25 fees. Please submit all fees as seen on your student’s Powerschool account prior to the start of the school year. Fees can be paid two ways:

1. Visiting [RevTrak](#) and submitting payment via credit card
2. Cash through our bookkeeper’s office in the C hallway OR at the optional check-in day on 7/31.

6. Athletics

Learn about sports seasons and [register to play fall sports](#).

7. Assessments (including the NMSQT)

Pay for NMSQT Exam, learn about upcoming assessments (PSAT9, PSAT10, SAT, CMAS)

8. Cafeteria/Food & Nutrition Services

Foods related questions. [Free/Reduced Lunch application](#) will be posted here when available as well.

9. Concurrent Enrollment Courses (CE)

Review expectations for a CE course. Review process and procedures to properly register for CE courses to ensure student receives college credit. More information will follow once the student starts class.

10. Advanced Placement Courses (AP)

Review expectations for an AP course. Review process and procedures for ordering and taking an AP exam. Students will order tests during the first 2 weeks of their class.

11. Transportation

Review relevant transportation information for students riding the bus to and from school. Please ensure you complete the relevant portions of parent forms as well.

The Blazer Commitment to Timely Attendance

The school day begins at 8:15 a.m. for Overland students. We expect students to be in their classroom at this time so they are ready to learn at 8:20 a.m. when the final bell rings.

Students are expected to arrive at school on time and attend every scheduled class on time. Late arrivals are an interruption to students already engaged in learning activities. It also results in a loss of instructional time for the tardy student.

Students who remain in the hallway at 8:15 a.m. will be asked to go to class promptly. Students who remain in the hallway after 8:20 a.m. will be required to pick up a tardy slip to enter their classroom. This could result in a consequence including, but not limited to detention, Saturday school, or loss of privileges.

For 2nd-4th periods, we also expect students to enter their classroom in a timely manner. Students should proceed to their class when the warning bell rings with approximately 2 minutes left in the passing period. Students who are not moving towards class at this time will be asked to go to class promptly. Students who remain in the hallway after the final passing period bell will be required to pick up a tardy slip to enter their classroom. This could result in a consequence including, but not limited to detention, Saturday school, or loss of privileges.

What do positive attendance habits look like?

IN SCHOOL	AT HOME
Attending over 90% of your classes (Rate TBD?)	Set a regular bedtime and wake up time at home
In class, engaged and ready to learn when the final bell rings	Avoid extended trips during the school year
Using the first 4 minutes of a passing period as you choose and then proceeding to class at the warning bell for the final 2 minutes of passing period	Communicate with your family regarding important dates, events, tests etc.
Creating and following lunch plans that allow you to be on time to your 3rd or 4th period class	
Communicate directly with your teachers in the event of an absence	

Missing more than 10% of school can have a significant impact on a student's ability to learn and keep up with content. This can be especially true if students are consistently missing certain periods, days, times, or classes. This also can negatively impact entire classrooms as students can end up in different stages of learning based on their attendance.
