It's been a great year! Starting soon you if you are a 9th-11th grader you will be picking your classes for next year. Please take the following into consideration as you start thinking about next year:

1. You Need 4 Core Classes: With a few exceptions, all OHS Students must take 4 Core Classes Every Semester (English, Social Studies, Science, Math). Your teacher will recommend your level (Honors, Regular, AP, CE). If you are interested in a higher-level course, talk with your current teacher in that subject.
2. Fine/Practical Arts & P.E.- All students need 1.5 credits of both Fine/Practical Arts and P.E. to graduate. DO NOT leave these to your senior year. Many areas count towards Fine/Practical Arts Credit (Business, Other FACS Classes, Music, Acting, etc.). Plan accordingly.
3. Specific Classes-All students must take and pass Health and Government to graduate. These classes typically are taken in 10th grade. Make sure you incorporate getting those credits done.
4. Foreign Language-While Foreign Language IS NOT REQUIRED to Graduate from Overland, 2 years of the SAME Foreign Language are required for most Colleges/Universities.
5. CCIC- The Cherry Creek Innovation Campus offers a wide variety of Career and Technical Education Pathways. The application is open and can be found here.
