Micro:bit: Intro Class - explore computer programming using the Micro:bit, a small microcontroller with programmable LED lights, sensors, and built-in wireless communication via radio and Bluetooth. In this course, students will be introduced to coding and basic computer programming concepts, such as variables, conditionals, and loops. Using the Micro:bit and an easy but powerful block-based coding environment, students will code fun projects. They will code an LED Matrix of the Micro:bit to display custom icons and animations, an accelerometer sensor to implement a dice rolling project and a paper-rock-scissor game, and create a reaction game that uses the buttons on the Micro:bit to trigger events. *NOTE: A \$10 fee for the rental of a Micro:bit is included.
