Dear Families,

Happy New Year and welcome back to school! I hope winter break and the few inches of snow and freezing cold temperatures provided ample time to spend with family and friends. A new year means a New Year's resolution. My resolution is to lose weight (again) AND keep a healthy perspective on what is truly important, and that is family, friends, and the importance of having a positive attitude and growth mindset. I feel especially blessed to be a part of the Altitude community and very thankful to be a part of Moose Nation. The staff and I are very excited to be back with your children as we begin the year 2024.

This time of year, prospective Cherry Creek parents begin to look at different elementary schools to plan on where their children are going to go to school. Their children may be starting kindergarten, or they may be enrolling in upper grades. School of Choice (starting now) is for parents who live in the Cherry Creek School District and want their children to go to a different Cherry Creek School aside from their home school. Open Enrollment is for parents that live outside the Cherry Creek School District and would like their children to go to a Cherry Creek School.

January begins the state testing season as well. Students will be taking their mid-year STAR assessment which helps us measure growth throughout the year. We have our English Language Learners taking the ACCESS assessment, and our third through fifth graders will take the Colorado Measurement of Academic Success (CMAS testing window is April 1 - May 2). We would like to thank the entire Altitude family for their support over the next few months. We will continue to inspire all students to think, to learn, to achieve, and to care.

I would like to share a quote from The Happiness Advantage by Shawn Achor. The quote is, "we can only learn to deal with failure by actually experiencing failure, by living through it. The earlier we face difficulties and drawbacks, the better prepared we are to deal with the inevitable obstacles along our path." Shawn uses this quote from the book The Pursuit of Perfect from Tal Ben-Shahar. Elementary school is the perfect place for students to lay the foundations for reading, writing and math, but more importantly, lay the foundations for dealing with stress and anxiety and how to be resilient and persevere. Thank you for modeling how to deal with stressful experiences. Your attitude and actions will help your children when they face events and obstacles much greater than those they ever faced in elementary school.

Student Health and Wellness Reminders from CCSD Health Services Department

The best way to remain healthy and prevent illness from spreading is through *good handwashing habits* (washing hands for 20 seconds with soap and warm water after using the bathroom, blowing nose, sneezing/coughing, and before/after eating), getting vaccinated for preventable diseases, and staying home when sick!

Stay home when sick!

- If your student is not feeling well enough to take part in their usual activities due to illness symptoms, they should stay home.
- If your student needs to be picked up from school, have a plan in place to pick them up as soon as possible.

Fever

- Defined as a body temperature over 100.4° F.
- Students may return to school after being 24 hours fever-free without the use of fever-reducing medication such as Tylenol (acetaminophen) or Motrin/Advil (ibuprofen).

Vomiting/Diarrhea

- Students may return to school 24 hours after the last episode of vomiting or diarrhea unless it is caused by an illness that requires them to stay home longer.
- If your student has a medical condition that causes them to have spit-up, reflux, or loose stools regularly, please work with your school nurse to develop a plan.

Cough

- Remind students to cough into their elbow; this helps keep the hands clean and decreases the spread of illness.
- · If the cough is severe or uncontrolled, keep your student home
- If a cough lasts longer than two weeks, we encourage checking in with your healthcare provider.

Lice

- Signs of lice:
 - Itching of the scalp, presence of live lice, eggs attached to the hair shaft, or small pinpoint scabs at the base of the hairline.
 - If live lice are present, students may remain in school until the end of the school day; however, they
 cannot return until after receiving an approved pediculicide (lice) treatment per CDPHE guidelines.
- Reminder: lice is a nuisance and not a public health concern.
 - This means it is not a reportable infectious disease, as it does not spread disease.
 - It is not due to poor hygiene habits.
 - We do not send notification letters home to the school community when lice cases are present, unless directed by the public health department.
 - We do not perform routine classroom-wide lice checks.

Vaccines

 Many childhood/school-aged illnesses can be prevented by receiving routine vaccines. Talk with your student's healthcare provider or school nurse for more information.


