Conference week is right around the corner, March 4th through March 8th. I want to thank all the parents ahead of time for participating in our conferences to help us meet the needs of our students and further strengthen our home-school partnership. Below is an excerpt from an article titled, <u>Developing Parent-School Partnerships</u>.

The importance of a partnership becomes more evident as we learn more about how children benefit from a strong teacher–parent relationship. All parties in the partnership have an equal role. School staff members are not inviting parents to be participants and provide input, but rather they have a vital role as true partners. The quality of the partnership affects the child's security and maximizes the child's potential for learning. This quality partnership includes frequent two-way communications, interest, and acceptance of the views of the other partner. The partnership grows through mutual consultation on important decisions, and working through differences with mutual respect (Keyser, 2006; Lightfoot, 2003).

Parents and teachers are not the only beneficiaries of a partnership. Children are the main benefit. When their parents and other significant adults in their life have a positive relationship with the teacher, children feel that they and their family are honored and respected. The better the relationship, the more the children feel that they, too, can have a trusting relationship with the teacher. They learn how to conduct social relationships by watching adult relationships. They notice all the nuances of language, body language, and tone of voice that the adults use. They use these positive models to develop their own relationships with others (Keyser, 2006).

Thank you for your support of Altitude and our teachers and students! Together we can make the experiences our children have at Altitude positive, fun, and successful.

## Attendance

Tardy/Attendance letters will be going home in a couple of weeks. If you have more than five absences or five tardies, you will receive a letter. This letter is to inform you of the number of absences and tardies your student has. You do not need to worry unless you are called to the front office to meet regarding absences and tardies. Our goal is a 95% attendance rate. This breaks down to three absences/tardies the first trimester, five the second, and seven total through the third trimester in a typical school year.

Research shows that children who are in school most of the time do better on assessments. Studies also show that kids who are absent often score lower on their schoolwork.

Being late for school hurts a child's learning, too. A student who is 10 minutes late every day will miss 30 hours of instruction during the year.

Children can copy notes or make up assignments, but they can never get back what's important: the discussions, the questions, the explanations by the teacher, and the thinking that makes learning come alive.

Your child's success in school depends on having a solid educational background – one that can only be gained through regular school attendance. We know students get sick during the school year, and that is a good reason to keep a student home. The purpose of the letters is for you to be aware of the total time missed from instruction.

## **REMINDERS/ANNOUNCEMENTS!**

Please help us get the word out for all **pre-kindergarten** and **kindergarten** students in the Altitude attendance area to go register their students as soon as they can! We are in the process of evaluating our enrollment, as it is very helpful to have a good handle on our numbers so we can keep our class sizes down and build a solid staffing plan. If you know of any pre-kindergarten and kindergarten Altitude Moose for the 2024-2025 school year, please tell them to go register right away (More info within this newsletter)! Any students that are affected by the boundary scenarios will be notified by district admissions.

Please pick up your students on time! We have many meetings immediately after school, and do not have the capacity to supervise students. We are in the planning stages for the 2024-2025 school year. Please make sure you are at Altitude on time to pick up students, no later than 2:45pm on M/T/TH/F, and 1:45pm on Wednesdays.

Regular daily school attendance is a critical factor in school success. Students who are frequently absent from school when they are not sick are at risk of falling behind in academic learning and development of social skills. Poor attendance in early grades can influence whether children read proficiently by the end of third grade. By sixth grade, chronic absence can be a predictor of whether a student is at risk for dropping out of school. We know there are times when a student has to miss school for illness or other reasons. However, we invite families to help us meet our goal of having every child in school every day.




