Practice Tests on Bluebook

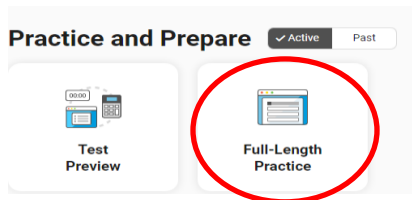
- You will need approximately 2.5 hours to complete the Practice tests
- Practice experience is the same as actual test experience
- No time lost for exiting and coming back
- Retake as many times as you want
- Bluebook app walks you through the test with a built-in timer – no additional instructions needed. You may use a calculator and 3 sheets of scratch paper if you choose to.

- [Download Bluebook](#) if it is not already on your device (school-issued devices should have it on the desktop).
- Sign in to your College Board Account:

If you do not have a College Board account, select update account at the bottom of the page and then select create an account.

- After signing in, select **Full-Length Practice**



- Select **PSAT-Related Assessments** or **SAT** depending on which test you want. Then **select which test you want to practice**. There are 4 SAT practice tests you can choose from.

- Timing**
This full-length practice test is timed like the real SAT, but you can pause any time by selecting **Save and Exit** from the **More** menu. You can also move from one section to the next before time expires.
- Scores**
When you finish the practice test, go to **My SAT** to see your scores and get personalized study tips.
- Assistive Technology**
If you use assistive technology, you should try it out on the practice test so you know what to expect on test day.

- If you test with approved accommodations, you can select which accommodations you will need.
