

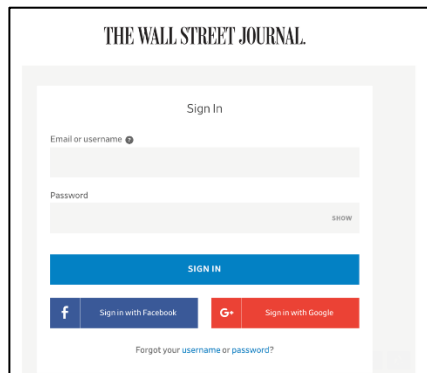

To login to WSJ.com, you can click on the Sign In link on the upper right hand corner:

Students and staff will use the following credentials to log-in to WSJ.com:

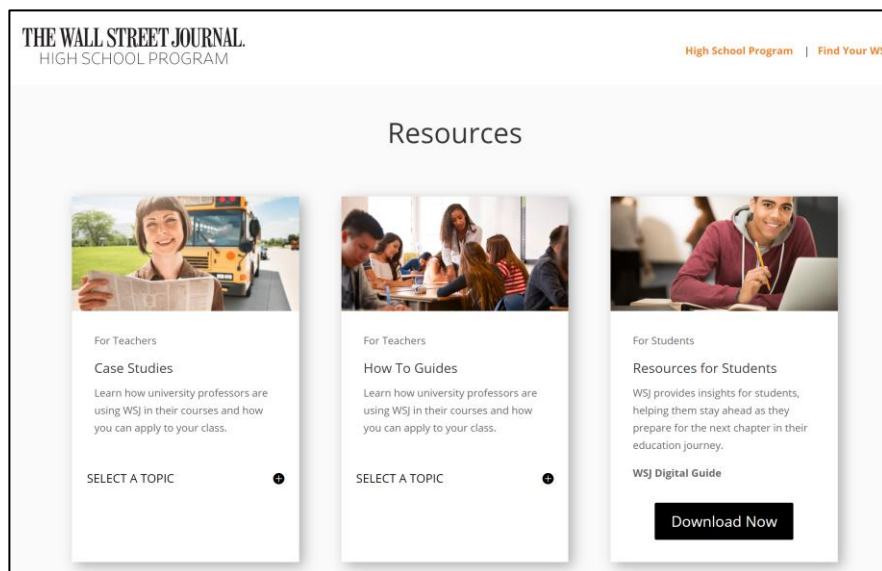

## What's Inside WSJ.com: Time-Saving Features

- 1. Get Up To Speed Quickly**  
Read **What's News** located at the top of the homepage, highlighting the most important and timely news.
- 2. Simplify Your Company Research**  
Access news, press releases, company profiles, financials, research, ratings and charting information for 30,000 companies all in one location. Enter the company name in the search box in the upper right-hand section of the homepage.
- 3. Excel In Your Classes**  
Delve into **industry-specific news**. Click on the tabs located on the homepage to select your topic of choice, from **Business** and **Markets** to **Tech** and **Economy**.
- 4. Go Global**  
Find WSJ's international news and markets data by going to the drop-down menu under The Wall Street Journal logo on the homepage (U.S. edition). To access country-specific information, click on the **World** tab and select the region.
- 5. Track Markets, Funds and Institutions**
