(these are available NOW and can be found in the Post Grad Center) and submit to Ms. Wilson in Post Grad.

Community College Fair

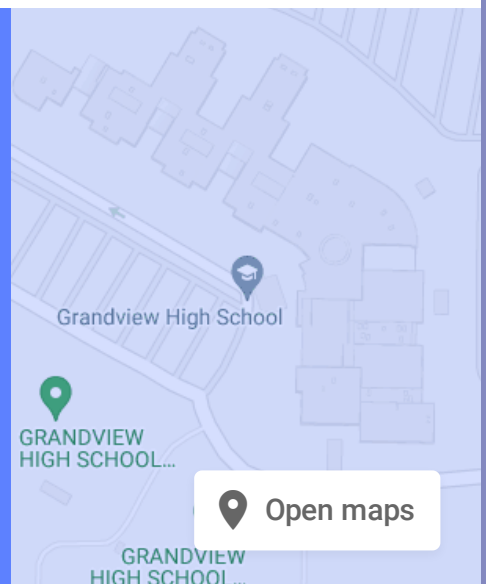
This fair is designed for Grandview seniors and juniors to meet with community college representatives during the school day.
