

Dear Grandview Parents/Guardians:

Due to current restrictions from COVID-19, Parent/Teacher conferences will look a little different this year. We will not be doing the arena-style, in-person conferences. Instead, during the week of October 5-9, teachers will be reaching out to you about your student's progress in their classes. Teachers may request a conference with you (via Microsoft Teams or phone call), or you may request to meet with them. For efficiency, the focus will be on students with grades of D or F in a class. We are at the mid-way point in the semester, so this timing is purposeful.

Additionally, you may have noticed two new codes when you pull up PowerSchool – RLP and RLNP. RLP – Remote Learning Present, and RLNP – Remote Learning Not Present are codes teachers are entering on Mondays in reference to the previous week of remote learning. These are codes that reflect engagement in courses, not necessarily attendance. Because engagement looks different in different courses, teachers have created a description to define Remote Learning Present (RLP) in that particular class. In PowerSchool, within their course description, teachers have explained how learning is calculated and what a remote learner (RLP) should do to show engagement. These are important pieces of information during this hybrid model of schooling.

Be sure to access PowerSchool to see your student's progress as well as attendance. PowerSchool also has an email notification option for parents. Schoology also has a feature for parents that allows them to receive emails that summarize their child's Schoology activity &/or overdue task information. (*Please note that grades in Schoology only include assignments completed in Schoology, so PowerSchool is the best place to go for accurate grade information.)

While this year has been a lot of "new" for our students and our teachers, the feedback loop we have experienced has pushed us all to think differently, teach differently, and learn differently.
