Dear CCHS Parents and Guardians,

We have been notified that one (1) Cherry Creek High School student tested positive for COVID-19 during the past week. ***Tri-County Health Department (TCHD) will contact you directly if further action is required. We are notifying you as part of our efforts to be transparent.***

If your student is exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (regardless of their vaccination status), they should not come to school. We encourage you to reach out to your healthcare provider and seek COVID-19 testing for anyone in your household with symptoms.
