Concurrent Enrollment: Earn high school credit and college credit at the same time. Courses offered through local community colleges and taught at CCSD high schools by accredited, post-secondary teachers. Courses are free if the student completes the required paperwork including Colorado Opportunity Fund (COF).

Dual Enrollment: Similar to Concurrent Enrollment. Families incur a small tuition cost to enroll. Courses offered through University of Colorado Denver/Succeed and taught at CCHS

Important Notes for CE

Some courses have prerequisites that must be met in order to be eligible to earn college credit.

Student must do the following to earn college credit in a CE course:

- Satisfy prerequisites
- Complete Student/ Parent Agreement
- Apply to the college
- Get a C or higher
- Be enrolled the entire term

For the course to be tuition free, the student must apply for COF (College Opportunity Fund) during the college application process.
